OUR MISSION

GOAL 1:

Build and mobilize a community of engaged loyal donors and partners.

Engage with our community to increase and diversify our new donors and maintain a high retention rate of current donors.

- Annual increase in existing donor retention rate to above industry average AND increase in new donors.
- Advocacy plan and training completed for the Board.

GOAL 2:

Promote and advocate for the clinical services needs for the hospital campus.

Advocate for the hospital's clinical services needs by working proactively and collaboratively with our health care partners to develop a Facilities Concept Plan that delivers exceptional healthcare.

- Advocate/engage our partners (FHA, Provincial Government, municipal – WR & Surrey) to influence/increase their support for PAH and the region.
- Develop a roadmap of hospital campus projects and priorities that meet the services needs of the community.
- Be an influencer and active partner in the design of the hospital campus based on the services needed by the community.
- Devise a "maximum and best use" land development plan.
- Board & Leadership team regularly invited to key meetings with healthcare partners and involved in key decisions.
- Confirmed fundraising amount and timeline for kitchen and ICU renovation campaigns.
- Board committee or task force accountable for recommending optimal use of hospital campus, based on Facilities Concept Plan and construction timelines.

Foster a thriving and inclusive community where every individual has the opportunity to lead a healthy life.

- Continue to improve overall physical and mental wellbeing for all community members, including those most vulnerable.
- Build strong social networks and community bonds, focusing on inclusive practices
